6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the licensing of veterinarians."

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 * Section 1. AS 08.98.050(3) is amended by adding a new subsection to
9 read:

10 (G) falsifies an official state or federal certificate
11 relating to veterinary medicine.

12 * Sec. 2. AS 08.98.210 is repealed and re-enacted to read:

13 Sec. 08.98.210. OUT-OF-STATE VETERINARIAN. An applicant who has
14 engaged in practice as a licensed veterinarian in another state or
15 territory of the United States may be licensed without written examina-
16 tion if

17 (1) he meets the qualifications of sec. 170 of this chapter;

18 (2) he has been engaged in licensed practice for five out of
19 the previous seven years before filing his application;

20 (3) he first passes an oral examination by the board; and

21 (4) the jurisdiction in which he holds his most recent
22 valid license extends the same privilege to those holding a license
23 from this state.
