6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to petitions for dissolution of an  
7 organised borough.."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 \* Section 1. AS 07.35.410 is repealed and reenacted to read:

10 Sec. 07.35.410. WHO MAY PETITION. A petition for the dissolu-  
11 tion of an organized borough may be filed with the local affairs  
12 agency. The petition shall be signed by and include the resident  
13 address of a per cent of qualified borough voters residing in each  
14 first class city and a per cent of qualified borough voters residing  
15 in the area outside first class cities according to the following  
16 schedule:

Number of Qualified Voters in	
First Class City or Area Outside City	Per Cent
7500 or less	25
Over 7500	15

21 The per cent of qualified voters shall be based on the total number  
22 who voted in person in the last regular borough election.
