6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to persons who are injured while
7 riding as guests in a motor vehicle."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 28.35 is amended by adding a new section to read:

10 Sec. 28.35.045. GUEST STATUTE. (a) No person transported by the
11 owner or operator of a motor vehicle as his guest, without payment for
12 the transportation, shall have a cause of action for damages against
13 the owner or operator for injury, death or loss in case of accident,
14 unless the accident was intentional on the part of the owner or opera-
15 tor or caused by his intoxication or by negligence consisting of a
16 wilful and wanton disregard of the rights of others.

17 (b) The provisions of (a) of this section shall not relieve a
18 public carrier or an owner or operator of a motor vehicle while it is
19 being demonstrated to a prospective purchaser of the responsibility for
20 injuries sustained by a passenger being transported by the public
21 carrier or by the owner or operator of the motor vehicle being demon-
22 strated.
