6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to persons who are injured while
7 riding as guests in a motor vehicle, vessel or air-
8 craft."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 * Section 1. AS 28.35 is amended by adding a new section to read:

11 Sec. 28.35.045. GUEST STATUTE. (a) No person transported by the
12 owner or operator of a motor vehicle, vessel or aircraft as his guest,
13 without payment for the transportation, shall have a cause of action
14 for damages against the owner or operator for injury, death or loss in
15 case of accident, unless the accident was intentional on the part of
16 the owner or operator or caused by his intoxication or by negligence
17 consisting of a wilful and wanton disregard of the rights of others.

18 (b) The provisions of (a) of this section shall not relieve a
19 public carrier or an owner or operator of a motor vehicle, vessel or
20 aircraft while it is being demonstrated to a prospective purchaser of
21 the responsibility for injuries sustained by a passenger being trans-
22 ported by the public carrier or by the owner or operator of the motor
23 vehicle, vessel or aircraft being demonstrated.
