6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the physical examination of school  
7 children."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 \* Section 1. AS 14.30 is amended by adding a new section to read:

10 Sec. 14.30.115. EXEMPTION FROM PHYSICAL EXAMINATION. (a) No  
11 child is obliged to submit to a physical examination required by sec.  
12 70 of this chapter if the parent or guardian of the child objects on  
13 grounds of religious principles. The objection shall be in writing,  
14 signed by the parent or guardian, and shall be delivered to the child's  
15 teacher or to the person having authority to order or conduct the  
16 physical examination.

17 (b) When, in the judgment of the person having this authority, a  
18 child shows symptoms of physical defects or disease or if he has been  
19 exposed to a contagious or infectious disease the child may be examined  
20 if notice is first given to the parent or guardian. The parent or  
21 guardian shall have the right to select the physician to conduct the  
22 examination.
