6 For an Act entitled: "An Act exempting certain handicapped persons from the
7 payment of parking meters."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 28.35 is amended by adding a new section to read:

10 Sec. 28.35.005. PARKING METER EXEMPTION. (a) Neither the state
11 nor any of its political subdivisions, home rule or otherwise, may
12 require payment into parking meters by a person who is physically
13 handicapped in such a way as to be unable to reach the meter.

14 (b) This exemption applies only when the handicapped person is
15 traveling alone.

16 (c) The Department of Public Safety shall adopt rules and
17 regulations implementing the purpose of this section.
