6 For an Act entitled: "An Act requiring the Department of Natural Resources  
7 to convey title to certain real property to certain  
8 named individuals; and providing for an effective  
9 date."

10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

11 \* Section 1. The legislature finds that it is in the best interest of  
12 the state to convey certain parcels of real property in the Knik River area  
13 to Jesse Lee Caudill, Albert D. Frey and Leon R. Walling, and finds that  
14 under existing general law the state is not obligated to make a conveyance  
15 which is satisfactory in this situation, although it has the authority to  
16 do so under sec. 6(g) of the Alaska Statehood Act, and that any reasonable  
17 general law which the legislature might enact would be inapplicable in this  
18 situation. The legislature further finds that the present situation is of  
19 a unique nature and that the necessary and desirable conveyance can be  
20 accomplished only by a special act of the legislature.

21 \* Sec. 2. The director of the division of lands of the Department of  
22 Natural Resources shall convey to Jesse Lee Caudill, Box 1162, Palmer,  
23 Alaska, upon payment of the sum of \$500, all of the state's right and title,  
24 excluding mineral rights, to the following property:

25 T17N, R3E, SM

26 Section 30: NE1/4SW1/4, N1/2SE1/4, SW1/4NE1/4 (160 acres).

27 \* Sec. 3. The director of the division of lands of the Department of  
28 Natural Resources shall convey to Albert D. Frey, Star Route A, Palmer,  
29 Alaska, upon payment of the sum of \$500, all of the state's right and title,

1 excluding mineral rights, to the following property:

2 T17N, R3E, S8

3 Section 19: S1/2SW1/4, NE1/4SW1/4, SW1/4SE1/4 (160 acres).

4 \* Sec. 4. The director of the division of lands of the Department of  
5 Natural Resources shall convey to Leon R. Walling, Box 1432, Palmer, Alaska,  
6 upon payment of the sum of \$500, all of the state's right and title, exclud-  
7 ing mineral rights, to the following property:

8 T17N, R3E, S8

9 Section 30: N1/2NW1/4, NW1/4NE1/4, SE1/4NW1/4 (160 acres).

10 \* Sec. 5. This act takes effect on the day after its passage and approval  
11 or on the day it becomes law without approval.
