6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the issuance of certain alcoholic
7 beverage licenses."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 04.15.020(e) is amended to read:

10 (e) Churches and schools. The board shall not issue a beverage
11 dispensary license or package liquor store license for the sale of any
12 intoxicating liquor in any building within 200 feet of a school ground
13 or church building measured by the shortest direct line from the
14 school ground or church building in which religious services are con-
15 ducted, within or without any corporate municipality nor for use in
16 any building within two miles of an accredited college or university
17 certified by the Northwest Association for the Accrediting of Institu-
18 tions of Formal Education, except that the board shall issue a beverage
19 dispensary or package liquor store license for use in a building within
20 two miles of an accredited college or university if (1) issuance of
21 the license is recommended by ordinance of the assembly of an organiz-
22 ed borough within which the college or university is situated and (2)
23 issuance of the license is authorized under other provisions of this
24 title. A license may be reissued or transferred from one licensee to
25 another, for the sale of intoxicating liquor in a building in which
26 that sale was authorized by law on April 25, 1960. When a license for
27 the sale of intoxicating liquor in a building within 200 feet of a
28 school ground or church building in which religious services are con-
29 ducted is forfeited, lapses or is transferred to other premises, no

license for the sale of intoxicating liquor at the prior licensed location shall thereafter be issued. However, the location may be relicensed in the event of the removal of either cause of the restriction.
