6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to penalties for violations of
7 municipal ordinances which govern the barter,
8 sale and possession of intoxicating liquor."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 * Section 1. AS 04.15.070 is amended to read:

11 Sec. 04.15.070. MUNICIPAL REGULATIONS. (a) An incorporated
12 municipality may by ordinance provide rules and regulations governing
13 the barter, sale and possession of intoxicating liquor within the
14 municipality necessary to the orderly conduct of the business of
15 selling intoxicating liquor. The ordinance shall not be inconsistent
16 with this title or the rules and regulations promulgated under this
17 title. No municipality may impose taxes other than property taxes on
18 liquor inventories and sales taxes on liquor sales when these taxes
19 are levied on other property and sales within the municipality.

20 (b) The provisions of sec. 100(b) of this chapter relating to
21 penalties for violation of this title apply also with respect to
22 penalties for violation of municipal ordinances adopted under the
23 authority of (a) of this section.
