6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the licensing of electrical
7 contractors; and providing for an effective date."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS OS. 40.190 is amended by adding a new paragraph to read:

10 (4) electrical contract work involving residences or small
11 commercial establishments in communities (A) which have a population
12 of under 300, or (B) which are over 50 miles by air or water transporta-
13 tion or 100 miles by road from the business place of an electrical
14 contractor licensed under this chapter. However, an electrical con-
15 tractor within the exclusionary provisions of this subsection is
16 subject to the inspection provisions of sec. 70 of this chapter and
17 must follow the regulations regarding workmanship promulgated in the
18 administrative code or he is liable for a fine of not more than \$300,
19 or imprisonment for not more than 60 days or both.

20 * Sec. 2. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage and approval
21 or on the day it becomes law without approval.
