6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the licensing of electrical
7 contractors; and providing for an effective date."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 08.40.190 is amended by adding a new paragraph to read:

10 (4) electrical work, the cost of which does not exceed
11 \$5,000, involving residences or small commercial establishments in
12 communities (A) which have a population of under 500, or (B) which are
13 over 50 miles by air or water transportation from the business place of
14 an electrical contractor licensed under this chapter. However, work
15 within the exclusionary provisions of this subsection is subject to
16 the inspection provisions of sec. 70 of this chapter and must follow
17 the regulations regarding workmanship promulgated in the administrative
18 code. A person who violates the provisions of this section is guilty
19 of a misdemeanor and, upon conviction, shall be liable for a fine not
20 to exceed \$300.

21 * Sec. 2. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage and appro-
22 val or on the day it becomes law without approval.
