6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the persons to whom intoxicating
7 beverages may be sold under a club license."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 04.10.070 is amended to read:

10 Sec. 04.10.070. CLUB LICENSE. A club license gives to clubs,
11 fraternal organizations, and patriotic organizations, that have a
12 state or national charter, and that have been so incorporated and
13 active for a period of two years or more, the right to sell intoxi-
14 cating liquors (TO MEMBERS AND THEIR FAMILIES ONLY) in their club
15 rooms to members and their families, and persons attending, or present
16 in connection with conventions if the club is located in an area which
17 is certified by the board as having inadequate facilities to meet the
18 temporarily increased need for alcoholic beverage dispensing facilities
19 ordinarily occasioned by conventions involving large numbers of persons.
20 The club license fee is \$400, except that where any club has certified
21 to the board that the gross sales of intoxicating liquor for the
22 preceding year were less than \$5,000 the club license fee is \$200.
