6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the hiring of persons through
7 Alaska labor unions."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 23.05.130 is repealed and re-enacted to read:

10 Sec. 23.05.130. HIRING THROUGH ALASKA LOCAL UNIONS. In order to
11 promote the welfare of the residents of the state by retaining in the
12 state the maximum amount of wages paid to employees, an employer doing
13 business in Alaska and using union labor shall hire or employ his
14 labor only through the Alaska local unions having jurisdiction and a
15 working agreement. A person who violates this section is guilty of a
16 misdemeanor and upon conviction is punishable by a fine of not more
17 than \$500.
