6 For an Act entitled: "An Act prohibiting gambling on trials or contests of
7 speed or endurance."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 11.60.140 is amended to read:

10 Sec. 11.60.140. DEALING OR CONDUCTING GAMBLING GAME. Unless
11 otherwise provided by law a [A] person who deals, plays, carries on,
12 opens or causes to be opened, or who conducts, either as owner,
13 proprietor or employee, whether for hire or not, a game of faro, monte,
14 roulette, rouge-et-noir, lansquenet, rondo, vingtum, twenty-one, poker,
15 draw poker, brag, bluff, thaw, craps, or a banking or other game
16 played with cards, dice, or other device, or any other game of chance
17 by whatever name known, whether played for money, or for checks, chips,
18 credit representing money, or other representative of value, or a
19 person who receives, records or registers bets, stakes or wagers, or
20 who sells pools, or makes a book upon the result of a trial or contest
21 of speed, skill or power of endurance, is guilty of a misdemeanor,
22 and upon conviction is punishable by a fine of not more than \$500, and
23 by imprisonment in a jail until the fine and costs are paid. A person
24 so convicted is punishable one day for every \$2 of the fine and costs.
25 The imprisonment shall not exceed one year.

26 * Sec. 2. AS 11.60 is amended by adding a new section to read:

27 Sec. 11.60.142. ACTIVITIES PROVIDED FOR IN AS 05.15 NOT GAMBLING.
28 The activities provided for in AS 05.15 shall not be considered as
29 coming within the provisions of sec. 140 of this chapter.
