6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to state ferry passage for state
7 employees; and providing for an effective date."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 39.20 is amended by adding a new section to read:

10 Sec. 39.20.185. FERRY PASSAGE FOR STATE EMPLOYEES. (a) After
11 two complete years of state service a state employee, except one desig-
12 nated in (e) of this section, the employee's family and their passenger
13 car are entitled to travel at one-half fare on the state ferries on a
14 space available basis. After three complete years of state service a
15 state employee, except one designated in (e) of this section, the
16 employee's family and their passenger car are entitled to travel free
17 on the state ferries on a space available basis.

18 (b) The state service required in (a) of this section shall not
19 have been broken by more than six months of unapproved leave.

20 (c) A numbered identification card containing a picture of the
21 state employee and his description, the department in which he is
22 employed, date of service, official seal, number and names of
23 dependents, shall be used to claim a reduced or free fare. The Depart-
24 ment of Administration shall prepare these cards for each requesting
25 state employee. The expense incurred for making up this card shall be
26 borne by the employee and shall be returned to the Department of
27 Administration upon termination of the employee.

28 (d) All other services including but not limited to staterooms,
29 food and beverages shall be borne by the employee.

(e) The provisions of this section shall not apply to any duly elected official.

* Sec. 2. A state employee who meets the requirements of AS 39.20.185(a) on the effective date of this Act is eligible for the benefits specified.

* Sec. 3. This Act takes effect June 1, 1967.
