6 For an Act entitled: "An Act providing for nonfederal-aid roads."

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 \* Section 1. AS 19.30 is amended by adding new sections to read:

9 ARTICLE 3. ROADS NOT ELIGIBLE OR NOT DESIGNATED

10 AS PART OF THE FEDERAL-AID HIGHWAY SYSTEM.

11 Sec. 19.30.100. PURPOSE. It is the purpose of secs. 100 - 130  
12 of this chapter to provide access to federal, state or private lands  
13 by roads not designated as part of the federal-aid highway system.

14 Sec. 19.30.110. CONTRACTS FOR CONSTRUCTION AND MAINTENANCE. The  
15 department may contract for the construction of roads in accordance  
16 with sec. 100 of this chapter. The department may, but not necessarily  
17 shall, either provide or contract for the maintenance of these roads.  
18 Contracts for the work shall be awarded to the lowest responsible  
19 bidder qualified to contract with the state.

20 Sec. 19.30.120. CONSTRUCTION STANDARDS. Roads constructed  
21 under secs. 100 - 130 of this chapter shall be of a standard deter-  
22 mined by the department for each specific road. Right of way width  
23 shall be determined by the division of lands and the department if  
24 constructed outside local government units. If these roads are  
25 constructed within the boundaries of local government units which  
26 have zoning ordinances, the width shall conform to the ordinances  
27 of the local government units.

28 Sec. 19.30.130. REPORT TO LEGISLATURE. The department shall  
29 provide the legislature, at the beginning of each session, a description

of all proposed nonfederal-aid highway system roads to be constructed during the next fiscal year. The legislature shall determine which projects shall be funded.
