6 For an Act entitled: "An Act creating the Alaska Immigration Agency."

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 * Section 1. AS 44 is amended by adding a new chapter to read:

9 CHAPTER 20. ALASKA IMMIGRATION AGENCY.

10 Sec. 44.20.010. ALASKA IMMIGRATION AGENCY ESTABLISHED. There is
11 in the office of the governor an Alaska Immigration Agency.

12 Sec. 44.20.020. DIRECTOR. The Alaska Immigration Agency is
13 administered by a director appointed by and serving at the pleasure
14 of the governor.

15 Sec. 44.20.030. PROGRAM. The Alaska Immigration Agency shall
16 administer a state program to aid qualified immigrants from foreign
17 nations to come to, settle in, and develop western and northern
18 Alaska. This aid shall include but not be limited to providing
19 transportation, building housing facilities, providing water and
20 sewer facilities, selling and leasing land, entering into contracts
21 with individuals or corporations to provide services, build facilities,
22 develop resources, and make loans.

23 Sec. 44.20.040. POWERS AND DUTIES. The Alaska Immigration
24 Agency has the following powers and duties:

25 (1) to apply for, to contract with and accept from the
26 federal government or other public or private agencies gifts, grants,
27 loans, and other assistance;

28 (2) to administer appropriated funds to carry out the
29 purposes of this chapter;

- (3) to acquire and dispose of real and personal property;
- (4) to employ necessary personnel;
- (5) to adopt regulations to carry out the purpose and intent of this chapter.
