6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the time statutes become effective;
7 and providing for an effective date."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 01.10.070(b) is amended to read:

10 (b) The actual effective date of a bill having no effective date
11 clause is determined by starting with the day after signature by the
12 governor or the day on which he gives written notice that he is allowing
13 it to become law without his signature, and counting 90 calendar days,
14 the law becoming effective at 12:01 a.m., Yukon [PACIFIC] Standard
15 time, on the 90th day.

16 * Sec. 2. AS 01.10.070(d) is amended to read:

17 (d) A law which specified a definite effective date becomes
18 effective at 12:01 a.m., Yukon [PACIFIC] Standard time, on the date
19 specified.

20 * Sec. 3. This Act takes effect on April 1, 1967.
