6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to persons licensed in the healing
7 arts and the testing of human functions."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 08 is amended by adding a new chapter to read:

10 CHAPTER 99. MISCELLANEOUS PROVISIONS.

11 Sec. 08.99.010. DESIGNATIONS REQUIRED TO BE USED BY THOSE LICENSEE
12 IN HEALING ARTS. (a) A person licensed in a healing art or the testing
13 of human functions shall suffix his name with the name of his particular
14 field of training on all signs, business stationery, advertising, and
15 in all cases where his name is made available to the public as a prac-
16 titioner of the healing arts or one who tests human functions.

17 (b) Except as provided for dental surgeons in this section, no
18 person may suffix his name with the word "surgeon" or the word "surgeon"
19 plus another word or words unless he is admitted in Alaska to the prac-
20 tice of medicine, or is commissioned as a medical officer in a federal
21 service. Dentists shall designate their skill as that of "dental
22 surgeon" or "doctor of dental surgery, D.D.S."

23 Sec. 08.99.020. INJUNCTION. The Department of Law shall enforce
24 the provisions of sec. 10 of this chapter by injunction.
