6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to persons licensed in the healing
7 arts and the testing of human functions."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 08 is amended by adding a new chapter to read:

10 CHAPTER 99. MISCELLANEOUS PROVISIONS.

11 Sec. 08.99.010. DESIGNATIONS REQUIRED TO BE USED BY THOSE LICENSED
12 IN HEALING ARTS. (a) A person licensed in a healing art or the test-
13 ing of human functions shall suffix his name with the name of his
14 particular field of licensure on all signs, business stationery, ad-
15 vertising, and other circumstances in which he offers his services to
16 the public as a practitioner of the healing arts or as one who tests
17 human functions.

18 (b) Except as provided for dental surgeons in this section, no
19 person may suffix his name with the word "surgeon" or the word "surgeon"
20 plus another word or words unless he is admitted in Alaska to the prac-
21 tice of medicine, or is commissioned as a medical officer in a federal
22 service. Dentists shall designate their skill as that of "dental
23 surgeon" or "doctor of dental surgery".

24 Sec. 08.99.020. INJUNCTION. The Department of Law shall enforce
25 the provisions of sec. 10 of this chapter by injunction.
