6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the public notice required for
7 meetings of public agencies."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 44.62.310(e) is amended to read:

10 (e) [REASONABLE PUBLIC] Public notice shall be given for all
11 meetings required to be open under this section, as follows:

12 (1) public notice of the schedule of regular meetings
13 shall be given at the beginning of each calendar or fiscal year;

14 (2) public notice of a special meeting or a rescheduled
15 regular meeting shall be given at least 24 hours before the meeting;

16 (3) public notice of an emergency meeting shall be given
17 at least two hours before the meeting;

18 (4) for regular, special, rescheduled and emergency meetings
19 public notice shall be given by posting a copy of the notice, stating
20 the time and place of the meeting, at the principal office of the
21 agency holding the meeting or, if the agency has no principal office,
22 at the building in which the meeting is to be held; if the agency has
23 a principal office but the meeting is to be held elsewhere notice
24 shall be posted at both locations; the agency shall supply copies of
25 the notice to every local newspaper of general circulation and to
26 every local radio and television station; for special and emergency
27 meetings the public notice shall include a statement of the subjects
28 to be discussed.
