6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the challenging of voters."

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 \* Section 1. AS 15.15 is amended by adding a new section to read:

9 Sec. 15.15.215. DISPOSITION OF CHALLENGED VOTES. (a) A  
10 challenged voter shall vote his ballot in the same manner as prescribed  
11 for other voters except that he shall use a paper ballot. After the  
12 election judge removes the identification number from the ballot, the  
13 challenged voter shall insert the ballot into a small blank envelope,  
14 seal it and put the envelope into a larger envelope on which the oath  
15 and affidavit he previously signed is contained. This envelope shall  
16 be sealed and deposited in the ballot box along with the attached  
17 statement of asserted invalidity. When the ballot box is opened,  
18 these envelopes shall be segregated and delivered to the official or  
19 body supervising the election where the merits of the challenge shall  
20 be determined by this official or body in accordance with the pro-  
21 cedure prescribed for challenged absentee votes in AS 15.20.210.

22 \* Sec. 2. AS 15.65 is amended by adding a new section to read:

23 Sec. 15.65.060. CHALLENGED VOTES. The provisions of secs. 210  
24 and 215 of this chapter concerning the challenging of voters apply to  
25 regular and special local government elections and to local annexation  
26 elections.
