6 For an Act entitled: "An Act requiring certain persons to obtain big game  
7 tags."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 \* Section 1. AS 16.05.340(a)(9) is amended to read:

10 (9) Nonresident hunting and sport fishing license . . . .20  
11 A nonresident, or resident who has maintained a permanent place of  
12 abode within the state for less than 24 consecutive months immediately  
13 preceeding a hunt, may not take a big game animal without previously  
14 purchasing a numbered, nontransferable, appropriate tag, issued to him  
15 as provided in (16) of this section. The tag shall be affixed to the  
16 animal immediately upon taking and shall remain affixed until the  
17 animal is prepared for storage, consumed, or exported.

20 Brown or grizzly bear, each . . . . . 75  
21 Polar bear, each . . . . . 150

24 Walrus, each . . . . . 100  
25 Elk, goats, or caribou, each . . . . . 25
