6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to termination of state employees;
7 and providing for an effective date."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 39.25.150 is amended by adding a new paragraph to read:

10 (24) an interview conducted by a qualified person when a
11 permanent employee voluntarily resigns; the following information shall
12 be requested with the employee's consent: details of the employee's
13 present position such as starting salary, present salary, length of
14 service, amount of schooling paid for by the state, reason for
15 resigning and details of his next position such as location, salary,
16 and fringe benefits.

17 * Sec. 2. AS 39.25 is amended by adding a new section to read:

18 Sec. 39.25.155. TERMINATION REPORT. (a) A person who conducts
19 an interview as provided in sec. 150(24) of this chapter shall send a
20 written copy of the interview to the Department of Administration for
21 filing. The Department of Administration shall submit an annual report
22 and summary of termination interviews to the legislative council each
23 January.

24 (b) The information gained during a termination interview shall
25 not, without consent of the employee, be used for any purpose not
26 specifically authorized by this Act.

27 * Sec. 3. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage and
28 approval or on the day it becomes law without approval.
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
