5 A BILL.

6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to workmen's compensation for
7 volunteer firemen."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 23.30.220 is amended by adding a new paragraph to read:

10 (5) if the employee is injured while performing his duties
11 as a volunteer fireman, the wage for calculating compensation shall be
12 the minimum wage paid a full-time fireman in the political subdivision
13 where the injury occurred, or if the subdivision has no full-time fire-
14 men employed, at a reasonable wage figure set by the subdivision for
15 the purpose of making this determination.

16 * Sec. 2. AS 23.30.265 is amended by adding new paragraphs to read:

17 (24) "volunteer fireman" means an individual whose name is
18 registered with the fire marshal of the state as a member of a regularly
19 organized volunteer or full-time fire department;

20 (25) "regularly organized volunteer fire department" is a
21 volunteer fire department registered with the fire marshal of the state
22 which has official recognition and financial support from the political
23 subdivision where it is situated.
