6 For an Act entitled: "An Act increasing the amount of assistance to  
7 dependent children."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 \* Section 1. AS 47.25.320(a) is amended to read:

10 (a) The department shall determine the amount of assistance  
11 for a dependent child and the relative with whom the dependent child  
12 is living, with regard to the resources and necessary expenditures of  
13 the family and the condition existing in each case. Assistance is  
14 sufficient if, when added to all other income and support available  
15 to the child, the child and relative have reasonable subsistence  
16 compatible with decency and health. However, the amount of assistance  
17 shall not exceed \$130 [\$80] when there is a relative and one child.  
18 If there is more than one child, the amount allowed for the relative  
19 and first child shall not exceed \$130 [\$80], and the amount for each  
20 additional child shall not exceed \$50 [\$30]. The maximum amount of  
21 assistance payable under this section is \$280.
