6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the sentence for first degree  
7 murder."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 \* Section 1. AS 11.15.010 is amended to read:

10 Sec. 11.15.010. FIRST DEGREE MURDER. A person who, being of  
11 sound memory and discretion, purposely, and either of deliberate and  
12 premeditated malice or by means of poison, or in perpetrating or in  
13 attempting to perpetrate, rape, arson, robbery, or burglary kills  
14 another, is guilty of murder in the first degree, and shall be sentenced  
15 to imprisonment for any term of years, but not less than 20 [YEARS TO  
16 LIFE].

17 \* Sec. 2. AS 11.15.020 is amended to read:

18 Sec. 11.15.020. OBSTRUCTING OR INJURING RAILROAD OR AIRCRAFT. A  
19 person who maliciously (1) places an obstruction upon a railroad or  
20 street railroad, or displaces or injures anything appertaining to a  
21 railroad or street railroad, or does any other act with intent to en-  
22 danger the passage of a locomotive or car, and thereby occasions the  
23 death of another, or (2) causes or attempts to cause damage or injury to,  
24 or places obstruction or explosive material on, in or about an aircraft,  
25 or who commits any other act with intent to endanger the safety of  
26 flight, operation or passage of an aircraft and thereby occasions or  
27 implements the death of another, is guilty of murder in the first degree,  
28 and shall be sentenced to imprisonment for any term of years, but not  
29 less than 20 [YEARS TO LIFE].
