6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the unauthorized use of a credit
7 card."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 11.20 is amended by adding a new section to read:

10 Sec. 11.20.365. UNAUTHORIZED USE OF CREDIT CARDS. (a) A person
11 who uses or attempts to use a credit card for the purpose of obtaining
12 goods, property, services, or anything of value, knowing his use or
13 attempted use to be without the consent of the owner, upon conviction,
14 is punishable by imprisonment as follows:

15 (1) if the value involved is less than \$100, imprisonment
16 for not less than three months nor more than one year;

17 (2) if the value involved is \$100 or more, imprisonment
18 for not less than one year nor more than five years.

19 (b) "Credit card" means any instrument, whether in the form of a
20 card, booklet, plastic or metal substance, or the number or other
21 identifying description of the instrument, which is sold, issued, or
22 otherwise distributed by a business organization or financial institu-
23 tion, for the use by the person or organization to whom it is issued
24 for obtaining on credit goods, property, services, or anything of
25 value.
