6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the time and cost of motor
7 vehicle registration."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 28.10.170 is amended to read:

10 Sec. 28.10.170. EXPIRATION OF REGISTRATION. Every vehicle
11 registration, every registration card, and every registration plate
12 issued under this chapter expire at midnight on December 31 [MARCH 1]
13 of each year. The owner of a registered vehicle may operate the
14 vehicle under the registration for the preceding year upon displaying
15 the registration plates issued for that year until May 31 of the year
16 for which the registration is required.

17 * Sec. 2. AS 28.10.180 is amended to read:

18 Sec. 28.10.180. RENEWAL OF REGISTRATION. The owner shall renew
19 his vehicle registration upon application and payment of the annual
20 license tax for the vehicle. The department may receive applications
21 for registration or renewal registration and issue new registration
22 cards and plates at any time before expiration of registration, but no
23 person may display the new registration plates on a vehicle before
24 January 1 [FEBRUARY 15] of the year for which the plates are issued.

25 * Sec. 3. AS 28.10.240 is amended to read:

26 Sec. 28.10.240. PRORATION OF TAX FOR REGISTRATION AFTER SEPTEMBER
27 [NOVEMBER] 30. The annual license tax on a motor vehicle, trailer,
28 or semi-trailer registered after September [NOVEMBER] 30 is one-half
29 the annual license tax imposed if the vehicle has not been illegally
