6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to annual and sick leave for per-
7 manent part-time employees of the state."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 39.20.200 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:

10 (b) Permanent part-time employees of the state are entitled to
11 annual leave with pay which accrues as follows:

12 (1) one and one-quarter days for each 165 hours of work in
13 the case of permanent part-time employees with less than two years of
14 service;

15 (2) one and three-quarters days for each 165 hours of work
16 in the case of permanent part-time employees with two but less than
17 five years of service;

18 (3) two days for each 165 hours of work in the case of per-
19 manent part-time employees with five but less than 10 years of service;

20 (4) two and one-half days for each 165 hours of work in the
21 case of permanent part-time employees with 10 years or more of service.

22 * Sec. 2. AS 39.20.260(a) is amended to read:

23 (a) Officers and employees are entitled to sick leave with pay
24 which accrues at the rate of one and one-quarter days for each full
25 monthly pay period. Permanent part-time employees are entitled to sick
26 leave with pay which accrues at the rate of one and one-quarter days
27 for each 165 hours of work. Sick leave which is not used during the
28 year in which it accrues accumulates and is available for use in
29 succeeding years.
