6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to scholarships for Alaska Natives."

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 \* Section 1. AS 14.40.520 is amended to read:

9 Sec. 14.40.520. SCHOLARSHIPS. The Board of Regents of the Uni-  
10 versity of Alaska shall offer not more than 50 [15] new scholarships  
11 for each academic year to Alaska Natives desiring to attend the Uni-  
12 versity of Alaska. The board shall give preference to Natives residing  
13 in the rural areas of the state who desire to receive training in the  
14 field of education. If there are more than 50 [15] applications the  
15 board shall award 50 [15] scholarships to those applicants who have the  
16 highest scholastic record or who the board determines are the most  
17 qualified among the applicants and who are financially unable to obtain  
18 a higher education without assistance. The University shall provide  
19 such minimum financial assistance to these students as is necessary in  
20 each individual case, but not exceeding fees, board and room.
