6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to false fire alarms."

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 ■ Section 1. AS 11.45 is amended by adding a new section to read:

9 Sec. 11.45.050. FIRE ALARMS. (a) A person who turns in a fire
10 alarm to fire fighting authorities knowing the alarm to be false, or
11 who causes another to turn in such an alarm, upon conviction, is guilty
12 of a misdemeanor and punishable by a fine of not to exceed \$300, or by
13 imprisonment in jail for not to exceed 30 days, or by both.

14 (b) In addition to the penalties in (a) of this section the court
15 may in its discretion require restitution by the convicted person to
16 the fire fighting authority involved for any and all expenses incurred
17 as a direct result of the false alarm.
