6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to work furloughs for prisoners."

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 * Section 1. AS 33.30.250(a) is amended to read:

9 (a) When a person is convicted of a felony of a nonviolent nature
10 or of a misdemeanor and is sentenced to a prison facility, or is
11 imprisoned in the prison facility for nonpayment of a fine, for
12 contempt, or as a condition of probation for a criminal offense, the
13 commissioner may, if he concludes that the person is a fit subject for
14 a work furlough, direct that the person be permitted to continue in
15 his regular employment, if that is compatible with the requirements
16 of (c) of this section, or may authorize the person to secure employ-
17 ment for himself, unless the court at the time of sentencing has ordered
18 that the person not be granted work furloughs.
