6 For an Act entitled: "An Act concerning grounds for arrest by a state  
7 trooper without a warrant; and providing for an  
8 effective date."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 \* Section 1. AS 12.25 is amended by adding a new section to read:

11 Sec. 12.25.035. ARREST WITHOUT WARRANT BY STATE TROOPER WHEN  
12 JUDICIAL OFFICER IS UNAVAILABLE. A state trooper may arrest a person  
13 without a warrant for a misdemeanor or for the violation of an ordinance  
14 when

15 (1) the officer has reasonable grounds to believe that the  
16 person to be arrested has committed a misdemeanor or has violated an  
17 ordinance; and

18 (2) personal or property damage is likely to be done unless  
19 the person is immediately arrested; and

20 (3) there is no known judicial office empowered to issue a  
21 warrant within a radius of 25 miles of the person to be apprehended.

22 \* Sec. 2. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage and  
23 approval or on the day after it becomes law without approval.
