6 For an Act entitled: "An Act increasing the State minimum salary schedule
7 for teachers; and providing for an effective date."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 14.20.220(a) is amended to read:

10 (a) The school board of each school district [IN THE SOUTH-
11 EASTERN AREA] shall pay a regularly qualified teacher employed by it a
12 salary not less than that set out in this subsection plus the regional
13 adjustments set out in (b), (c), (f) or (g) of this section.

14 (1) The base salary of a teacher with three years' training
15 is \$5,400 [\$5,000] for a teacher with no public school experience in
16 the state. The salary is augmented by \$200 for each year of public
17 school experience in the state up to and including four years.

18 (2) The base salary for a teacher holding a bachelor's
19 degree and having the requisite number of hours in education is
20 \$6,400 [\$6,000]. This salary is augmented by the sum of .04 times
21 the base for each year of public school experience in the state up
22 to and including eight years.

23 (3) The base salary for a teacher having a master's degree
24 and the required number of hours of education is \$6,900 [\$6,500].
25 This salary is augmented by the sum of .04 times the base for each
26 year of teaching experience in the state up to and including 12 years.

27 * Sec. 2. AS 14.20.220(d) is amended to read:

28 (d) The department, as the operating agency of schools outside
29 school districts, shall pay a regularly qualified teacher employed by

1 the state a salary of not less than \$1,100 [\$500 A YEAR PLUS THE USUAL
2 HOUSING ALLOWANCE] above the salary established by (a), (b), (c), (f)
3 or (g) of this section, with an increment of \$300 for a bachelor's
4 degree plus 18 hours training, and an equal increment of \$300 for a
5 master's degree plus 18 hours training. However, in the state-operated
6 schools, for teachers with bachelor's degrees or higher instead of
7 augmenting the base salary by .04, each salary shall be augmented by
8 .05 times the base for each year of public school experience in the
9 state up to and including eight years for teachers with a bachelor's
10 degree, 10 years for teachers with a bachelor's degree plus 18 hours
11 of training, 12 years for teachers with a master's degree, and 14
12 years for teachers with a master's degree plus 18 hours of training.
13 The base salary used in this subsection is the actual beginning salary,
14 for a teacher with a bachelor's degree and no experience. in the area
15 where the teacher will teach.

16 * Sec. 3. This Act takes effect July 1, 1968.
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
