6 For an Act entitled: "An Act increasing the penalty for violation of a
7 statute or regulation dealing with sea otter; and
8 providing for an effective date."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 * Section 1. AS 16.05.900(a) is amended to read:

11 (a) Except as provided in (c) of this section, a [A] person who
12 violates secs. 830, 870 - 895, or 920 of this chapter or any rule or
13 regulation promulgated under this chapter is guilty of a misdemeanor
14 and upon conviction, is punishable by a fine of not more than \$1,000
15 or by imprisonment for not more than six months, or by both. A person
16 who violates a rule or regulation promulgated under this chapter for
17 the regulation of commercial fisheries shall be punished as provided
18 in sec. 720 of this chapter.

19 * Sec. 2. AS 16.05.900 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:

20 (c) A person who violates a statute or a regulation dealing with
21 sea otter is guilty of a felony and, upon conviction, is punishable
22 by a fine of not more than \$5,000, or by imprisonment for not more
23 than two years, or by both.

24 * Sec. 3. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage and
25 approval or on the day it becomes law without approval.
