7 For an Act entitled: "An Act amending the state Military Code; and provid-
8 ing for an effective date."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 * Section 1. AS 26.05.190(c) is amended to read:

11 (c) The adjutant general may require a bidder to whom a contract
12 is awarded to give bond running to the state in the sum and with the
13 surety he directs, conditioned upon the faithful performance of the
14 contract. In case of breach of the conditions of the bond, action
15 shall be brought on it under supervision of the attorney general,
16 and all money recovered shall be turned into the state treasury
17 [MILITARY FUND]. All stores, supplies, or property purchased under
18 contract shall be rigidly inspected by an officer detailed for that
19 purpose by the adjutant general, and compared with standard supplies
20 and stores of the same character, before they are accepted and paid
21 for.

22 * Sec. 2. AS 26.05.260(g) is amended to read:

23 (g) Necessary charges incurred in cases stated in this section
24 shall be paid from the state general fund [MILITARY FUND] by appropriate
25 vouchers.

26 * Sec. 3. AS 26.05.270 is amended to read:

27 Sec. 26.05.270. All bills, claims and demands for military
28 purposes shall be certified and audited as prescribed by law and shall
29 be paid from the state general fund [MILITARY FUND] in the normal

1 manner upon submission of vouchers by the adjutant general. If the
2 organized militia, or any part of it, is called into active service of
3 the state in case of war, disaster, insurrection, rebellion, turmoil,
4 riot, invasion, breach of peace, or to execute or enforce the law,
5 vouchers for legally allowed pay and expenses for this service or com-
6 pensation for injuries shall be drawn upon the general fund of the state
7 treasury and paid out of money in that fund not otherwise appropriated.

8 * Sec. 4. AS 26.05.330(a) is amended to read:

9 (a) The expense incident to and connected with the holding of
10 military courts in this state under this chapter shall be paid out of
11 the state general fund [MILITARY FUND] under orders, rules and regu-
12 lations issued by the adjutant general with the approval of the
13 governor.

14 * Sec. 5. AS 26.05.330(d) is amended to read:

15 (d) All fines levied and collected under this section shall be
16 paid to the department of revenue for deposit in the state general
17 fund [MILITARY FUND].

18 * Sec. 6. AS 26.05.330(g) is amended to read:

19 (g) All expenses incident to conduct of military boards shall
20 be paid upon proper vouchers drawn against the state general fund
21 [MILITARY FUND].

22 * Sec. 7. AS 26.05.330(h) is amended to read:

23 (h) If a member of the National Guard is prosecuted by civil
24 or criminal action for an act performed or committed by him or any
25 act caused, ordered or directed by him to be done or performed in
26 furtherance of and while in the performance of his military duty,
27 the expense of the defense of the action, civil or criminal, including
28 attorney's fees, witness fees for the defense, defendant's court
29 costs and all costs for transcripts of records and abstracts on appeal

1 by the defense, shall be paid out of the state general fund (MILITARY
2 FUND).

3 * Sec. 8. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage and
4 approval or on the day it becomes law without approval.
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
