6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to door to door salesmen."

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 • Section 1. AS 08 is amended by adding a new chapter to read:

9 CHAPTER 93. SALESMEN.

10 Sec. 08.93.010. IDENTIFICATION CARD. (a) No person may sell a
11 commodity or a service from door to door in the state unless he is
12 wearing a salesman identification card issued by the Department of
13 Commerce.

14 (b) The salesman identification card shall contain the name of
15 the salesman, his employer's name and address, and a number assigned to
16 the salesman.

17 Sec. 08.93.020. RECORD OF IDENTIFICATION CARDS. The Department
18 of Commerce shall keep a permanent record of the information on the
19 salesman identification cards issued, which record shall be open to the
20 public.

21 Sec. 08.93.030. FEE. The Department of Commerce shall establish
22 a fee for the issuance of the salesman identification card equal to the
23 cost of the administration of this chapter.

24 Sec. 08.93.040. REGULATIONS. The Department of Commerce may prom-
25 ulgate regulations necessary to carry out the purpose of this chapter.

26 Sec. 08.93.050. PENALTY. A person who violates a provision of
27 this chapter is guilty of a misdemeanor and, upon conviction, is punish-
28 able by a fine of not less than \$10 or more than \$25 for each day of
29 violation.
