7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA: .

8 * Section 1. AS 22.15.170(b) is amended to read:

9 (b) The presiding judge of the superior court in each judicial
10 district may appoint acting district judges as needed to serve at
11 his pleasure for a term of no longer than 12 months or until succeeded
12 by an appointment made under (a) of this section, whichever first
13 occurs. An acting district judge shall be a citizen of the United
14 States and of the state, at least 21 years of age, but need not be
15 licensed to practice law in any of the United States and need not
16 have established Alaska residence before his appointment. Service as
17 an acting district judge is not considered as judicial service for the
18 purposes of ch. 25 of this title.
