6 For an Act entitled: "An Act granting legislators travel pay to and from  
7 home during a session for the purpose of conferring  
8 with constituents; and providing for an effective date."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 \* Section 1. AS 24.15.050 is amended to read:

11 Sec. 24.15.050. TRANSPORTATION ALLOWANCE. (a) Each member of  
12 the legislature is entitled to receive one round-trip transportation  
13 fare not to exceed the cost of first-class airline fare from his place  
14 of residence in the election district from which elected or appointed  
15 to the capital for purposes of attending regular, reconvened regular,  
16 or special sessions of the legislature. Each member receiving trans-  
17 portation fare is entitled to a baggage allowance not to exceed the  
18 cost of 100 pounds excess baggage by air each way upon submission of  
19 proper documentation to substantiate the baggage shipment.

20 (b) For the purpose of conferring with his constituents, each  
21 member of the legislature who resides outside the capital is entitled  
22 to receive during a regular or special session of the legislature one  
23 round-trip transportation fare not to exceed the cost of the lowest  
24 class airline fare from the capital to his place of residence in the  
25 election district from which elected or appointed, and return.

26 \* Sec. 2. This Act takes effect if AS 24.15.010 is amended to provide  
27 that legislators who reside in the capital city shall not receive per diem.
