6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the impersonation of a peace  
7 officer, magistrate, public official, or public  
8 employee."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 • Section 1. AS 11.30.220 is amended to read:

11 Sec. 11.30.220. IMPERSONATING PEACE OFFICER, MAGISTRATE, PUBLIC  
12 OFFICIAL OR EMPLOYEE. A person who falsely assumes to be a magistrate,  
13 [OR] peace officer, elected or appointed public official, or public  
14 employee, and acts as such, [AND REQUIRES A PERSON TO AID OR ASSIST  
15 HIM IN ANY MATTER PERTAINING TO THE DUTY OF A MAGISTRATE OR PEACE  
16 OFFICER,] upon conviction, is punishable by imprisonment in jail for  
17 not less than three months nor more than one year, or by a fine of not  
18 less than \$50 nor more than \$500.
