6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to service of process; changing
7 Rule 4(a) and repealing Rule 4(c) of the Supreme Court
8 Rules of Civil Procedure."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 * Section 1. Rule 4(a) of the Supreme Court Rules of Civil Procedure is
11 amended to read:

12 (a) SUMMONS -- ISSUANCE. Upon the filing of the complaint the
13 clerk shall forthwith issue a summons and deliver it for service to a
14 peace officer or to any competent person over the age of 21 years who
15 is a resident of the state and is not a party to or an attorney in the
16 action [A PERSON SPECIALLY APPOINTED TO SERVE IT]. Upon request of
17 the plaintiff separate or additional summons shall issue against any
18 defendants.

19 * Sec. 2. Rule 4(c) is repealed.
