6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to false pretenses."

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 * Section 1. AS 11.20.360 is amended read:

9 Sec. 11.20.360. OBTAINING MONEY OR PROPERTY BY FALSE PRETENSES.

10 (a) A person who, by false pretenses or by a privy or false token,
11 and with intent to defraud, obtains, or attempts to obtain money or
12 property from another, or who obtains, or attempts to obtain, with
13 intent to defraud, the signature of a person to a writing, the false
14 making of which is a forgery, upon conviction, is punishable by im-
15 prisonment in the penitentiary for not less than one nor more than five
16 years.

17 (b) A person who represents a future event, with present knowledge
18 of its falseness, for the purpose and with the present intent to defraud
19 another of money or property is guilty of a felony and upon conviction
20 is punishable by imprisonment for not less than one nor more than five
21 years.
