6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to motor vehicles."

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 • Section 1. AS 28.35.010 is amended by adding new subsections to read:

9 (e) A person who drives, tows away, or takes a vehicle not his
10 own without the consent of the owner, with intent to permanently deprive
11 the owner of possession of the vehicle is guilty of a felony and upon
12 conviction is punishable by imprisonment for not less than one year nor
13 more than two years.

14 (f) A person who breaks or enters a vehicle without the owner's
15 consent, with the intent to permanently deprive the owner of personal
16 property contained in the vehicle, or who removes some part of the
17 vehicle without the owner's consent, whether or not by breaking and en-
18 tering the vehicle, with intent to permanently deprive the owner of its
19 use and possession, is guilty, if the personal property or part exceeds
20 \$50 in value, of a felony and upon conviction is punishable by imprison-
21 ment for not less than one nor more than two years. If the value of
22 the personal property or part taken does not exceed \$50 in value the
23 person is guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction is punishable by
24 imprisonment for any term less than one year.
