6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to motor vehicles."

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 • Section 1. AS 28.35.010 is amended by adding new subsections to read:

9 (e) A person who drives, tows away, or takes a vehicle not his  
10 own without the consent of the owner, with intent to permanently de-  
11 prive the owner of possession of the vehicle is guilty of a felony and  
12 upon conviction is punishable by imprisonment for not less than one year  
13 nor more than ten years, or by a fine of not more than \$10,000, or by  
14 both.

15 (f) A person who breaks or enters a vehicle without the owner's  
16 consent, with the intent to permanently deprive the owner of personal  
17 property contained in the vehicle, or who removes some part of the  
18 vehicle without the owner's consent, whether or not by breaking and  
19 entering the vehicle, with intent to permanently deprive the owner of  
20 its use and possession, or who wilfully damages the vehicle or damages  
21 it in the process of breaking or entering it, is guilty of a felony if  
22 the personal property or part taken or the damage done exceeds \$50 in  
23 value, and upon conviction is punishable by imprisonment for not less  
24 than one nor more than ten years, or by a fine of not more than \$10,000  
25 or by both. If the value of the personal property or part taken or the  
26 damage done does not exceed \$50 the person is guilty of a misdemeanor  
27 and upon conviction is punishable by imprisonment for not more than one  
28 year, or by a fine of not more than \$1,000, or by both.
