6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to centralized occupational and  
7 professional licensing; and providing for an effective  
8 date."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 \* Section 1. AS 08.01.010 is amended by adding a new paragraph to read:

11 (15) Board of Construction Contractors

12 \* Sec. 2. AS 08.01.100 is amended to read:

13 Sec. 08.01.100. LICENSE RENEWAL, LAPSE AND REINSTATEMENT. (a)

14 All licenses shall be renewed biennially on the dates set by the  
15 department with the approval of the respective board.

16 (b) A registration, license, permit or certificate requiring  
17 renewal to continue effective must be renewed on or before the date  
18 set by the department or it will lapse. A penalty of \$10 shall be  
19 charged in addition to all delinquent renewal fees for reinstatement  
20 of a registration, license, permit or certificate which remains  
21 lapsed for more than 60 days.

23 Sec. 08.04.430. EXPIRATION AND RENEWAL. Any permit or  
24 registration under secs. 390 - 420 of this chapter [EXPIRES ON

26 renewed biennially [BY THE BOARD ANNUALLY] upon payment of a renewal  
27 fee in the same amount as the initial biennial [ORIGINAL] fee.

29 Sec. 08.88.241. REINSTATEMENT OF LAPSED LICENSE. A licensee

1 is required to take an examination before a license, which has  
2 remained lapsed more than three years, may be reinstated.

4 Sec. 08.98.200. BIENNIAL [ANNUAL] RENEWAL AND REINSTATEMENT.

5 A person who passes the examination is licensed without payment of  
6 further fee. To remain licensed, a person must pay the renewal fee  
7 [BEFORE FEBRUARY 1 OF EACH YEAR]. [THE BOARD SHALL RENEW A LAPSED  
8 LICENSE WHEN A VETERINARIAN WHOSE LICENSE HAS LAPSED APPLIES FOR  
9 RENEWAL AND PAYS ACCRUED RENEWAL FEES.] A person whose license has  
10 lapsed is entitled to have his license renewed without taking an  
11 examination unless his license has lapsed more than five years.
