6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the regulation of municipal
7 utilities under the Alaska Public Service Commission
8 Act."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 * Section 1. AS 42.05.640(2) is amended to read:

11 (2) "public utility" or "utility" includes every corpora-
12 tion, whether municipal, public, cooperative, or otherwise, company,
13 individual, or association of individuals, their lessees, trustees, or
14 receivers appointed by a court, that owns, operates, manages, or
15 controls a plant [ANY PLAN] or system for the generation, transmission,
16 or distribution of electric energy and power, for the furnishing of
17 telephone or telegraph communications, for the transmission or dis-
18 tribution of heat, natural or manufactured gas, oil or other petroleum
19 products, or water, or for the furnishing of community sewer services,
20 [AND] the plant and facilities used for any of the foregoing purposes;
21 this chapter does not apply to a person who furnishes water or oil or
22 other petroleum products by tank, wagon, or similar conveyance [, NOR TO
23 A MUNICIPALLY OWNED AND OPERATED UTILITY]; this chapter does not apply
24 to a pipeline, plant, system, or equipment used primarily for gathering,
25 collecting, transporting, or shipping crude oil, natural gas, condensate
26 or other petroleum substance or product produced by or belonging to the
27 owner, operator, or manager of the pipeline, plant, system, or equipment
