6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the punishment for certain
7 felonies."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 11.15.010 is amended to read:

10 Sec. 11.15.010. FIRST DEGREE MURDER. A person who, being of
11 sound memory and discretion, purposely, and either of deliberate and
12 premeditated malice or by means of poison, or in perpetrating or in
13 attempting to perpetrate, rape, arson, robbery, or burglary kills an-
14 other, is guilty of murder in the first degree, and shall be sentenced
15 to imprisonment for not less than 20 years to life, except that a per-
16 son who is found guilty of murder in the first degree of a peace
17 officer and the murder occurred while the person was perpetrating or
18 attempting to perpetrate a robbery shall be sentenced to death.

19 * Sec. 2. AS 11.15 is amended by adding a new section to read:

20 Sec. 11.15.015. RAPE OF A FEMALE UNDER 13 YEARS OF AGE RESULTING
21 IN HER DEATH. A person who, being of sound memory and discretion,
22 purposely, and in perpetrating or attempting to perpetrate rape upon a
23 female person 13 years of age or under, kills her, is guilty of murder
24 in the first degree, and shall be sentenced to death.

25 * Sec. 3. AS 11.15.130 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:

26 (d) A person 19 years of age or older convicted of rape upon
27 a female person 13 years of age or under, may be punishable by death.

28 * Sec. 4. AS 11.15 is amended by adding a new section to read:

29 Sec. 11.15.017. KIDNAP RESULTING IN DEATH. A person who, being

1 of sound memory and discretion, purposely and without lawful reason
2 kidnaps, abducts, or carries away and holds for ransom, reward or other
3 unlawful reason another person, and the kidnapping results in the death
4 of that person, shall be punishable by death.

5 • Sec. 5. AS 11.15.260 is amended to read:

6 Sec. 11.15.260. KIDNAPPING. A person who knowingly and without
7 lawful reason kidnaps, abducts or carries away and holds for ransom,
8 reward or other unlawful reason another person, except in the case of a
9 minor by his parent, is punishable by imprisonment for a term of years
10 or for life, or by death.
