6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to purchasing and processing of fish  
7 in Alaska."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 \* Section 1. PURPOSE. The purpose of this Act is to give protection to  
10 the American fishermen against foreign competition to the extent that this  
11 can be done in light of validly existing United States treaties.

12 \* Sec. 2. AS 16.10 is amended by adding a new section to read:

13 Sec. 16.10.211. PURCHASING OR PROCESSING OF FISH. All fish  
14 purchased for processing or processed in the state must be purchased  
15 from fishing or processing boats owned and operated by citizens of the  
16 United States.

17 \* Sec. 3. AS 16.10.220 is amended to read:

18 Sec. 16.10.220. PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION OF SECS. 200, [AND] 210  
19 AND 211 OF THIS CHAPTER. A person who violates secs. 200, [AND] 210  
20 and 211 of this chapter is guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction  
21 is punishable by a fine of not more than \$5,000, or by imprisonment for  
22 not more than one year, or by both.
