5 A BILL

6 For an Act entitled: "An Act directing the secretary of state to conduct a
7 poll of the electorate with respect to whether
8 organized boroughs should be limited to school
9 functions."

10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

11 * Section 1. The secretary of state is directed to prepare a proposition
12 to be placed on a separate ballot for submission to the electorate of the
13 state at the state general election of November 5, 1968 and requesting the
14 voters to indicate a "Yes" or a "No" on the following question:

15 "In place of a first or second class borough, do you favor
16 establishment of a third class borough limited to school
17 functions only and having powers similar to those of school
18 districts existing when Alaska was a Territory?"

19 * Sec. 2. The results of the poll directed in sec. 1 of this Act shall
20 be certified by the secretary of state and submitted to the First Session of
21 the Sixth Legislature for the action it considers appropriate and necessary.
